Disabled parking bays

Blue badge holders displaying their badge are entitled to free, unlimited parking in any bays within the car park. All car parks also have an allocation of disabled bays that are only permitted for the use of blue badge holders. No complimentary ticket from the machine is required when Blue Badge holders use our car parks.

On street parking for Blue Badge holders

Parking is allowed on double yellow lines and single yellow lines, for a maximum of 3 hours providing badge and clock are clearly displayed.

Please note though that there is limited parking allowed in the waiting bays -Parking in Barton Street disabled bay is for only 1 hour

Areas where blue badge holders are not permitted to park in Gloucestershire include: Where there is a loading ban in force denoted by yellow kerb markings, In bus stops and taxi ranks and in permit holder only bay

Please refer to the Blue badge booklet that you would have received for further guidance and how to use your badge correctly.

Motorcycle parking

Motorcycle parking is free of charge in all of our pay and display car parks. However, when parking your motorcycle please avoid using coach and disabled bays.

Motorhome Parking

Station Road, Rails Meadow, Oldbury Road and Vineyards car parks have height restriction barriers. All other car parks are available for motorhomes provided that all wheels fit within a standard bay. Larger limited spaces are available in Spring Garden car park. Bay size, they are all 2.4m by 4.8 metres

Electric car charging points

Four double 7 kW chargepoints have been installed providing capacity to charge eight vehicles in Spring Gardens car park, GL20 5LR

The charge points will cost 50p per kWh plus 30p transaction fee.

Drivers can access them using the Evolt app, zap map, web pay and with RFID cards to begin charging, using their own cables to connect the car to the chargepoint.

The chargepoint layout has been designed following the latest PAS1899 mobility guidance ensuring ample room around the vehicles for all users.

Additional electric charging points are available at the Public Services Centre on Gloucester Road, Tewkesbury, GL20 5TT in the car park at the rear of the building
